Red Ribbon Club is a movement empowering students in educational institutions in the age group of 17 to 25 by giving them information and life skills to protect themselves from HIV and AIDS, and also by training them into peer educators for spreading awareness both in campuses as well as in community.

The Red Ribbon Club in Baptist College was formed on 3rd August 2006, initiated and supported by the Nagaland State AIDS Control Society (NSACS). Since its inception in the college, the RRC has carried out a wide range of activities and training programs like peer educators training, workshops, group discussions, painting and slogan writing competition with themes on HIV/AIDS awareness, blood donation camps, campaigns on HIV/AIDS awareness, healthy living, sanitation drives etc, and has also participated in important events and observance of important days organized by the NSACS.

These various RRC activities in the College are conducted with the following objectives:

- To bring the awareness among the students about HIV/AIDS infections and its preventive measures.
- To promote regular voluntary non-remunerated blood donation by the students so as to increase the access to safe and adequate quantities of blood in order to help the needy during emergencies.
- To sensitize the students regarding care and support of people living with HIV/AIDS and instill in them the spirit to reduce the stigma and discrimination against them.
- To train the students as peer educators to spread awareness within and outside the campus.



1.	12 th to 16 th June 2017	The RRC members went to all the classes to promote the club and motivate the students to join the club. IEC materials and RRC materials were also distributed to the students.

Sl. No.	Date	Activities Conducted
1.	11 th June 2018	The RRC, Nodal Teachers interacted with the students of all the semesters in their respective classes, to promote the club and motivate the students to join the club. Application forms for joining the club was given to the students.
2.	14 th June 2018	World Blood Donor Day, was observed at Baptist College, Kohima on the theme and slogan "Be There For Someone Else" and "Give Blood, Save Life" respectively. The program was jointly organized by NSACS and RRC, Baptist College, in collaboration with Naga Hospital Authority, Kohima. About 200 students attended the program, where the Principal, Baptist College gave the welcome address. Dr. Ngangshimeren, Project Director, NSCAS and Dr. Seyiechutuo Solo, incharge, Blood Bank, NHAK spoke on the occasion. Vote of thanks was delivered by Alipoker, Assistant Director, Voluntary Blood Donation, and NSACS. The Blood Donation drive began after the program was conducted. About 40 students volunteered to donate blood. However, after necessary testing done, 26 students and 2 teachers, Mr. Kezholesa Dominic and Dr. Chiete donated blood. The donors were given badges and refreshments.
