Students:

1. Any grievances related to academics and other matters can be resolved and shared through the Staff and Student Grievance Portal available on the college website. The Student Grievance Redressal and Welfare Committee addresses the issues for an early resolution.
2. The Career Guidance and Remedial Committee organizes various career counselling programs to assist students in their learning and future preparation. Additionally, exposure trips, educational tours, talks, workshops, fieldwork, and industrial projects are arranged to enhance their learning experience.
3. Certified computer courses with Diploma in Computer Application and Tally with GST is introduced every academic year at subsidised rate as an add on course.
