SAZOLIE COLLEGE 18TH INTER-COLLEGE DEBATE

The 18th Inter-Collegiate Debate Competition under the topic, *Nagaland is a Safe Place for Women*, is scheduled on **20th of March, 2026** for UG level only.

A. Specimen copy of Rules and Regulations:

1. Colleges are to send only one participant. Theological Colleges are requested to send only B.Th students.
2. Participants should prepare for both the motions (FOR and AGAINST) and the allocation for the same (Treasury or Opposition Bench) shall be decided by drawing of lot before the commencement of the debate. Therefore, students are requested to reach the college one hour before the competition.
3. Leaders for the motion and against the motion will be chosen by drawing of lot before the debate.
4. Time allotted to the debaters will be 4 minutes. There will be a warning bell after 3 minutes, and a final bell after 1 minute.
5. An additional 2 minutes each will be given to leaders from the motion and against the motion at the end of the debate. The points will be added to the group and not to their individual score, except for the leader of the treasury bench.
6. Heckling shall not be allowed in the midst of the debate. Time will be given to the audience which will be as per discretion of the moderator.
7. Participants should avoid reading/presenting from a prepared note.
8. The criteria for marking are mentioned in the Score Sheet.
9. The decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding in case of any.
