



1. The *Kikia* and the green hills represent the rich culture of the land and people from which we derive our identity. Knowledge and education acquired must not alienate a student from his/her culture. Rather it should infuse greater appreciation and stronger relationship with one's culture and identity.
2. The *open Book* represents the Word of God. The scripture says, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge" (Proverbs 1:7; 9:10). Apart from the required curricula set by the University, making God first in the lives of the students is what will make the College an institution of distinction.
3. The Latin words *In Excelsis* means "in the highest degree". This is the ultimate goal of the College.
4. The *cap* represents academic achievement of both the College and the students. *In Excelsis* is measured, not necessarily in securing high marks alone, but the content of the whole academic exercises that result in a wholesome education that makes both the College and the students outstanding.
